Privacy and Confidentiality

Student Health abides by HIPAA and FERPA laws, which protect medical and certain educational records.

The Buckley Form does not give parents access to medical records.



We cannot release any information except in cases of emergency, or when a patient has given us specific written permission at the time of their visit.

Immunizations

Certain immunizations are required by NC law.

Students not in compliance with state law will be administratively withdrawn from classes.



Records must be submitted to SHS by August 28 or a \$100 fee will apply.

Insurance

Health insurance is a requirement for students meeting specific eligibility criteria. An affordable Student Health Insurance Plan (SHIP) is offered through Student Blue from Blue Cross and Blue Shield of North Carolina, or students may elect to keep their current health insurance coverage if they are already covered by an individual plan or through a parents' plan.

What To Send With Your Student

First aid/illness kit

- *Over the counter medications*
- *Thermometer*
- *Band-aids, simple first aid supplies*
- *Crackers*
- *Soup, ramen, easy to prep food*
- *Fluid replacement (sports drinks, packets for water)*



Copy of current insurance information

List of any allergies they have or medications they take (put it in their "Notes" on their phone)

New Pirate Checklist



Immunization records must be received and complete by August 28. Academic withdrawal is mandatory if requirements are not met.



Fill out the Report of Medical History form on myPIRATEchart to tell us about medical history, allergies, and other important health information



Enroll in, or waive out of, the health insurance requirement.



Students under 18 must have a consent form for treatment signed by a parent/guardian on file to receive services.
